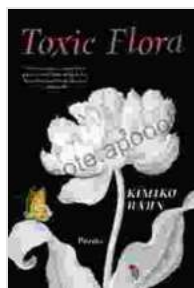


Toxic Flora: Poems by Kimiko Hahn

To your beauty and your danger.”

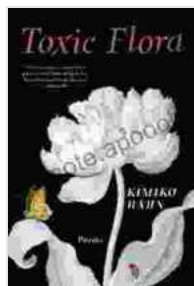
